Core Differences and Light Propagation

Single-mode (SM) fiber has a very small core, typically 8-10 microns in diameter, allowing light to travel in a single, straight path. This minimizes modal dispersion, enabling high-speed data transmission over long distances, up to 100 km or more, making it ideal for telecommunications, FTTX deployments, and long-haul networks . Multi-mode (MM) fiber has a larger core, usually 50-62.5 microns, which allows multiple light paths simultaneously. While this increases modal dispersion and limits effective distance (typically up to 400 meters for modern OM4/OM5 fibers), it is well-suited for short-range applications like data centers, LANs, and building networks .

Light Sources and Equipment

SM fiber requires high-precision lasers (e.g., DFB lasers) to inject light accurately into the narrow core, which increases system cost. MM fiber can use lower-cost LEDs or VCSELs, making it more economical for short-distance deployments .
