

Loss of Low-Voltage Optical Cables

Loss in low-voltage optical cables, also called attenuation, is the reduction of optical signal strength due to intrinsic fiber properties and extrinsic factors like splices, connectors, and bending.

Types of Optical Fiber Loss

Intrinsic losses originate from the fiber material itself and include:

- **Absorption loss:** Light energy is absorbed by the fiber material, typically silica, converting it to heat. Modern fibers are optimized for 1300–1550 nm wavelengths to minimize this loss .
 - **Scattering loss:** Caused by microscopic variations in the fiber core, leading to Rayleigh scattering of light .
 - **Dispersion loss:** Spreading of light pulses over distance, which can reduce signal clarity .
- Extrinsic losses are due to installation and operational conditions:
- **Connector loss:** Imperfect alignment or surface quality at connectors can cause 0.3–0.75 dB loss per connector depending on type .
 - **Splice loss:** Fusion or mechanical splices introduce small losses, typically 0.15–0.3 dB per splice .
 - **Bending loss:** Sharp bends or microbends in the cable can leak light out of the core .
