

Material cutting dimensions requirements for cable tray elbows



Article Overview

Cable tray elbows require a minimum bend radius of 12–48 inches with a 3-inch tangent, and cutting dimensions depend on tray width, angle, and material type.

Bend Radius and Tangent Requirements

Cable tray elbows must maintain a minimum bend radius to prevent cable damage and ensure proper support. Standard radii for elbows are 12, 24, 36, or 48 inches, depending on the tray size and application . Each elbow should include a 3-inch tangent at the start and end of the bend to allow smooth cable entry and exit .

Elbow Angles

Elbows are typically fabricated at 30°, 45°, 60°, and 90° angles. The cutting dimensions of the material must account for the angle of the elbow and the radius, ensuring that the tray maintains its structural integrity and proper cable support .

Rung Spacing and Load Considerations

For ladder-type trays, rung spacing is critical. Common spacings are 6 inches (150 mm), 9 inches (225 mm), and 12 inches (300 mm), with larger trays sometimes using up to 36 inches (900 mm) spacing . Rungs must have a minimum cable-bearing surface of 7/8 inch and be capable of supporting the cable load with a safety factor of 1.5 and a 200 lb concentrated load
