If a Netcom fiber optic cable has no wire markings, identification relies on color-coded fibers, jacket characteristics, or manufacturer documentation to safely determine fiber type and sequence.

Understanding Fiber Identification

Fiber optic cables typically follow the TIA/EIA-598-C color coding standard, which assigns specific colors to individual fibers within a cable. For example, the first 12 fibers are colored Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate, White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose, and Aqua. In cables with more than 12 fibers, the sequence repeats with additional markings such as stripes to maintain unique identification for each fiber group .

Options for Unmarked Cables

- Check the Cable Jacket: Even if individual fibers are unmarked, the outer jacket may contain printed legends indicating fiber type, count, or specifications. Premises cables often include this information directly on the jacket, while outdoor cables may rely on color-coded jackets or printed legends .
- Use Fiber Color Coding: If the cable contains multiple fibers, the internal fibers may still follow the standard color sequence. Carefully strip the outer jacket and inspect the buffer tubes or individual fibers for color coding, which can guide splicing and termination .
- Manufacturer Documentation: Netcom or the cable supplier may provide datashe...
