What is a Fiber Cut

A fiber cut occurs when the thin glass or plastic strands inside a fiber optic cable are physically damaged or severed, interrupting the transmission of light signals that carry data, voice, and video across networks . This can result in complete loss of connectivity or significant degradation of service for affected users, as fiber optic networks are the backbone of modern communication .

Common Causes

Fiber cuts can happen due to a variety of external and internal factors:

- **Construction and Excavation:** Accidental strikes by backhoes, drills, or other heavy machinery are the most frequent cause, often referred to as “Digger's Law” .
- **Natural Disasters:** Floods, earthquakes, landslides, and severe weather can damage both buried and aerial cables .
- **Animal Activity:** Rodents such as gophers, squirrels, and mice can chew through cable sheathing and fibers, particularly in underground or rural installations .
- **Equipment or Human Error:** Defective cables, connector issues, improper splicing, or excessive bending during installation or maintenance can also lead to cuts or signal degradation
