

Noise from the electrical distribution box during thunderstorms



Article Overview

The noise you hear from an electrical distribution box during thunderstorms is usually caused by electrical surges, electromagnetic interference from lightning, or arcing within the system.

Causes of the Noise

- **Power Surges from Lightning** Thunderstorms generate strong electric fields and lightning strikes, which can induce sudden voltage spikes in your electrical system. These surges can travel through power lines and cause audible buzzing, crackling, or popping sounds in your distribution box .
- **Electromagnetic Interference (Atmospheric Noise)** Lightning discharges produce electromagnetic waves that can induce currents in nearby wiring. This phenomenon, known as atmospheric noise, can create static-like or humming sounds in electrical equipment, especially in sensitive circuits .
- **Arcing or Loose Connections** High voltage surges can cause small arcs inside the distribution box if connections are loose or components are worn. This arcing produces a noticeable crackling or sizzling sound and can be a fire hazard if not addressed .

Safety Considerations

- Do not touch the distribution box during a storm, as voltage spikes can be dangerous.
- Check grounding and surge protection: Proper grounding and whole-house surge...
