

Optical Cable Connection Methods within Power Conductors



Overview

Optical attached cable (OPAC) is a type of fibre-optic cable that is installed by being attached to a host conductor along overhead power lines. There are two types of these cables, OPGW (optical power ground wire) and OPPC (Optical power phase conductor) cables. The most common solution is to hang the ADSS directly on the support points. IEEE Std 1222, "IEEE Standard for All-Dielectric Self-Supporting Fiber Optic Cable (ADSS) for Use on Overhead Utility Lines" is published by the IEEE. The International American Society of Testing and Materials (ASTM) Standards exist for specific material tests such as tracing and erosion resistance. It should be recognized that, for power transmission systems, OPPC cables are primarily used in voltage levels below 110kV, such as suburban distribution networks and rural.
