Fiber optic cables are generally safe for the public, but handling and installation require precautions due to glass shards, laser exposure, and chemical use.

Physical Safety Hazards

Fiber optic cables themselves do not carry electrical current and are non-conductive, making them safer than copper cables in terms of electrical hazards . However, tiny glass or plastic fibers can break off during cutting, splicing, or trimming. These shards are difficult to see and can cause skin irritation, eye injury, or internal harm if ingested. Proper disposal in sealed containers and wearing safety glasses, gloves, and protective clothing is essential .

Laser and Light Exposure

Fiber optics transmit data using lasers or LEDs, which can be harmful if viewed directly. Even low-power infrared light, invisible to the eye, can damage the cornea or lens if focused through a microscope. Technicians should never look directly into a fiber end without proper equipment and should use infrared filters when necessary . The risk to the general public is minimal, as the light is contained within the fiber core .
