An Optical Cross-Connector (OXC) switches optical signal pairs between fiber inputs and outputs entirely in the optical domain, maintaining protocol transparency and high-speed transmission.

Overview of OXC Functionality

An Optical Cross-Connector (OXC) is a network device that routes optical signals from any incoming fiber to any outgoing fiber without converting them to electrical signals, preserving the data rate and protocol transparency . In the context of a fiber optic signal pair, each pair typically consists of a transmit (Tx) and receive (Rx) fiber, which the OXC can dynamically switch to different output ports while maintaining signal integrity .

Signal Routing Process

- **Signal Reception:** Incoming fiber pairs carrying WDM or DWDM channels are received by the OXC .
- **Demultiplexing:** Each wavelength channel is separated into individual signals if multiple wavelengths are present .
- **Switching:** The separated signals are directed through a photonic switching matrix or wavelength-selective switch (WSS), which interconnects multiple input and output fibers in a non-blocking topology .
- **Re-multiplexing and Transmission:** Signals are recombined (if necessary) and transmitted over the selected output fiber pair, ensuring low insertion loss and mini...
