

Optical Module Port Matching



Article Overview

To ensure two optical modules work together, you must match their wavelength, speed, fiber type, and port compatibility.

Key Factors for Matching Optical Modules

1. Wavelength Compatibility Both optical modules must operate at the same wavelength to enable proper signal transmission. For example, a 1310nm module cannot communicate with an 850nm module. Mismatched wavelengths can cause data loss or degraded performance, so always verify the wavelength specifications of both modules before connecting them . 2. Speed and Duplex Mode Modules must support the same data rate and duplex mode. A full-duplex module should be paired with another full-duplex module. For instance, a 1G SFP module may fit into a 10G SFP+ port, but the speed will be limited to 1 Gbps. Conversely, a 10G SFP+ module cannot operate in a 1G-only SFP port. Some 10GBASE-T modules support multiple speeds (1G, 2.5G, 5G, 10G) using Cat5e/Cat6/Cat6a cables . 3. Fiber Type The fiber optic cable must match the module type. Multimode modules (typically 850nm) should be used with multimode fibers (OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, OM5), while single-mode modules (typically 1310nm or 1550nm) require single-mode fiber. Using incompatible fiber types can prevent the connection from establishing . 4. Port and Device Compatibility Ensure the modules are compatible with the switch or media converter ports. Some vendors restrict SFP/SFP+ modules to their own branded devices, while others follow MSA standards allowing cross-vendor interoperability. Check the vendor's supported transceiver list and verify EEPROM coding if necessary to avoid "unsupported transceiver" errors . 5. Proper Cabling and Connection For duplex fiber connections, ensure the transmit (TX) and receive (RX) lines are correc...
