- **Modulator Chips:** Often based on silicon photonics, these chips encode electrical data onto optical carriers, enabling high-speed transmission .
- **DSP Chips:** In high-speed modules (400G, 800G), digital signal processing chips handle signal equalization, error correction, and encoding/decoding .
- **Driver and Control Chips:** These manage laser operation, modulators, and photodetectors, providing power control, thermal management, and synchronization .
