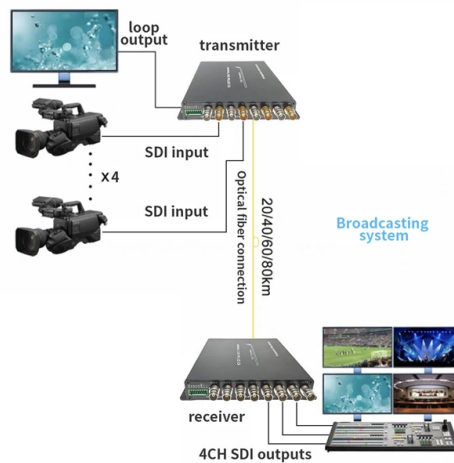


Outdoor Aerial Optical Cable Laying

Outdoor aerial fiber optic cables are installed above ground on poles or pylons using specialized cables and safety procedures to ensure durability, performance, and compliance with standards.

Cable Types and Design

Outdoor aerial cables are designed to withstand environmental stress such as wind, ice, UV exposure, and temperature fluctuations. Common types include:

- All-Dielectric Self-Supporting (ADSS) cables: Self-supporting, can be installed near power lines without a messenger wire, reducing installation costs and enabling pole sharing .
- Loose tube cables: Contain buffer tubes with multiple fibers, suitable for lashed aerial or duct installations, lightweight and durable .
- Ribbon cables: High fiber density, allow mass-fusion splicing for faster installation and restoration .
- Polyethylene (PE) jackets with carbon black: Protect against UV degradation; black is the standard color for aerial installations .

Planning and Route Preparation

Before installation, careful planning is essential:

- Route survey: Identify poles, pylons, and obstacles; check ground conditions and environmental factors

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Aerial cables are suspended from poles or pylons or mounted on buildings. Some are self-supporting, requiring no separate

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cables that may sag near the fiber optic cable. Determine the clearances between the proposed fiber optic cable plant and existing
