The PE (Protective Earth) wire in distribution boxes is typically marked with a green-and-yellow color combination to ensure clear identification and safety compliance.

Color Coding for PE Wire

The PE wire, also known as the protective earth or ground conductor, is universally identified by a green-and-yellow striped insulation. This marking is standardized in international guidelines such as IEC 60446/60445, which specify that green-and-yellow is exclusively reserved for protective conductors and must not be used for any other purpose. For single-core wires, the green-and-yellow stripe should cover 30–70% of the conductor length, ensuring visibility at both ends. In older or non-standard installations, the PE wire may appear as solid green, but modern practice favors the green/yellow combination for safety.

Labeling in Distribution Boxes

In addition to color coding, labeling the PE wire in distribution boxes improves maintenance efficiency and reduces errors. Many junction boxes provide preset marking areas where you can write directly on the box or use adhesive labels. For example, you can mark the PE wire as "PE" or "Earth" using a permanent marker or printed label. This is especially useful in complex installations with multiple circuits, where clear identification prevents accidental disconnection or miswiring.
