

Pre-reserved length for fiber optic cable laying joints



Article Overview

The typical pre-reserved length for fiber optic cable at splicing or joint points ranges from 1 to 3 meters, depending on the installation type, splice tray, and future maintenance needs.

General Guidelines

When planning fiber optic cable installations, it is essential to leave extra fiber length at joints and splice points to accommodate splicing, routing, and potential future re-termination. This pre-reserved length ensures that fibers are not stressed, maintains proper bend radius, and allows for easy handling during maintenance or upgrades ().

- Slack in splice trays: Most splice trays require 1 to 2 meters of fiber to be coiled neatly without exceeding the minimum bend radius. Ribbonized or loose-tube fibers may require slightly more slack depending on tray design ().
- Manholes and junction boxes: For underground or duct installations, 2 to 3 meters of extra fiber is commonly left in manholes or handholes to allow for routing, looping, and future splicing ().
- Figure-8 loops: On surface installations or during cable pulling, fiber is often coiled in figure-8 loops of 2 to 4 meters to prevent twisting and kinking, which also contributes to the pre-reserved length ().
