

Quantity of cables in cable trays



Article Overview

The number of cables in a cable tray depends on tray dimensions, cable size, and allowable fill percentage, typically 40% for data cables and 50% for power cables.

Key Factors Affecting Cable Tray Capacity

- **Tray Size:** The internal width and depth of the tray determine the total area available for cables. Standard widths range from 50 mm to over 600 mm depending on application, with narrow trays for instrumentation and wide trays for heavy industrial or data center installations .
- **Cable Size:** The diameter of each cable affects how many can fit. For circular cables, the cross-sectional area is calculated as $\pi \times (\text{diameter}/2)^2$.
- **Allowable Fill Capacity:** To ensure proper ventilation and maintenance access, industry standards recommend filling trays to a maximum of 40% for data cables and 50% for power cables .

Step-by-Step Calculation

- **Calculate Tray Area:** Multiply tray width by tray depth. For example, a 100 mm × 50 mm tray has an area of 5,000 mm².
- **Determine Allowable Fill Area:** Multiply the tray area by the fill ratio. For data cables in the example tray: 5,000 mm² × 0.40 = 2,000 mm².
- **Calculate Cable Cross-Sectional Area:** For a CAT5E cable with a 5.5 mm diameter: $3.14 \times (5.5/2)^2 \approx 23.76$ mm².
- **Estimate Number of Cables:** Divide allowable fill area by cable area: $2,000 \text{ mm}^2 \div 23.76 \text{ mm}^2 \approx 84$ cables .
