Excessive Data Traffic and Bandwidth Demand

Optical modules are designed to handle specific data rates, such as 40G, 100G, or higher. When network traffic exceeds the module's rated capacity, the module may experience overloading, leading to increased bit-error rates (BER), signal distortion, or intermittent link failures. High-capacity transport systems like DWDM, OTN, and DCI networks are particularly sensitive to traffic surges, which can push modules beyond their optimal operating range .

Signal Degradation and Optical Power Imbalance

Overcapacity can also result from optical power anomalies. Excessive or insufficient optical power can damage receivers, distort signals, or trigger forward error correction (FEC) overloads. Factors such as fiber attenuation, connector contamination, or misaligned optical components can exacerbate these issues, effectively reducing the module's usable capacity . Maintaining stable and well-controlled optical power is critical to prevent overloading the module's processing capabilities.
