Optical Fiber: The Core Transmission Medium

An optical fiber is a thin, flexible strand of glass or plastic designed to transmit light signals over long distances with minimal loss . Its structure consists of a core, where light travels, surrounded by cladding with a lower refractive index to ensure total internal reflection, keeping the light confined within the core . Fibers are coated with a protective layer to prevent damage during handling, and they come in single-mode (for long-distance, high-bandwidth transmission) and multi-mode (for shorter distances) types . Optical fibers are immune to electromagnetic interference, non-conductive, and capable of transmitting large amounts of data at high speeds .

An optical cable is an assembly that contains one or more optical fibers bundled together within a protective sheath . The cable provides mechanical strength, environmental protection, and ease of installation. It typically includes:

- Buffer coatings around each fiber for additional protection
