Function of the 50 Relay

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Instantaneous Overcurrent Protection: The primary function of a 50 relay is to provide instantaneous protection against overcurrent conditions. This means that when the current exceeds a predetermined threshold, the relay will trip the circuit breaker without any intentional time delay, typically in less than 0.1 seconds. This rapid response is crucial for protecting electrical equipment from damage due to short circuits or other fault conditions .

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Application: The 50 relay is particularly useful in applications where quick fault clearance is essential, such as in critical industrial processes or in systems where equipment could be severely damaged by prolonged overcurrent conditions. It is commonly used in medium voltage (MV) and high voltage (HV) panels, often in conjunction with circuit breakers .
