Overview of Protective Relays

Protective relays are control and measurement devices that monitor electrical quantities such as current, voltage, frequency, impedance, or differential values. When a relay detects a condition exceeding its preset limits, it sends a trip signal to a circuit breaker to isolate the faulted section, ensuring minimal disruption to the rest of the system. Relays do not interrupt current directly; they rely on breakers to perform the actual disconnection.

Key Principles of Relay Protection

- **Reliability:** Relays must operate correctly under fault conditions and remain inactive during normal operation.
- **Selectivity (Discrimination):** Relays should isolate only the faulted section without affecting healthy parts of the system.
- **Speed:** Relays must act quickly to prevent equipment damage but avoid unnecessary tripping.
- **Sensitivity:** Relays must detect faults even under low-magnitude conditions or during abnormal system states.
- **Coordination:** Relays are coordinated with upstream and downstream devices to e...
