Removing fiber optic cables requires careful handling to prevent damage to the cable, connected equipment, and your eyes.

Safety Precautions

Fiber optic cables transmit data as light through extremely thin glass or plastic fibers, which are fragile and can be damaged easily. They also carry invisible infrared laser light that can harm your eyes if viewed directly, even briefly . Before attempting removal:

- Power down equipment: Unplug the modem, router, or Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to ensure the fiber port is inactive .
- Use protective measures: Wear safety glasses if available, and avoid looking directly into the cable ends or transceiver ports .
- Maintain a clean workspace: Dust or debris can scratch the fiber tip, reducing signal quality .
- Handle cables gently: Avoid bending beyond the minimum bend radius, twisting, or applying excessive force .
