

Requirements for organizing cable trays in low-voltage electrical rooms



Article Overview

Low-voltage cable trays must be properly supported, separated from power cables, grounded, and routed to ensure safety, accessibility, and minimal electromagnetic interference.

Support and Structural Requirements

Cable trays should be independently supported from the building structure with fastenings capable of carrying the present and future load multiplied by a safety factor of at least four or 200 lbs., whichever is greater (). Expansion connectors must be installed where trays cross building expansion joints or in runs exceeding 90 feet. Trays should not be used as walkways or for personnel support ().

Separation and Layout

- Electrical vs. Instrumentation Cables: Power cables should be positioned above low-voltage or instrumentation cables to reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI) ().
- Minimum Spacing: Maintain at least 300 mm (12 inches) vertical and horizontal separation between power and signal/control trays. If space is limited, metal partitions can be used to prevent interference ().
- Routing: Cable trays should follow straightforward, shortest practical paths to minimize bends, junctions, and cable length, reducing material costs and signal loss ()....
