Key Safety Concerns

Always avoid looking directly into fiber ends and use a power meter or visual fault locator to check for active light before inspection. Eye protection is mandatory when working with fiber optics . **Glass Fiber Hazards:** Tiny glass strands can break off during cutting, splicing, or terminating cables. These shards can cause skin punctures or eye injuries. Always handle fibers carefully, dispose of scraps in sealed containers, and wear gloves and safety glasses . **Chemical Exposure:** Cleaning and splicing fibers often involve chemicals like isopropyl alcohol, epoxy, or curing agents. Prolonged inhalation or skin contact can cause respiratory issues or irritation. Use gloves, goggles, and ensure proper ventilation when working with these substances . **Physical and Construction Hazards:** Fiber optic installation may involve working at heights, using tools, or working near electrical infrastructure. Standard construction safety practices, including hard hats, protective clothing, and adherence to OSHA regulations, are essential .
