General Safety Considerations

Mobile optical cable construction involves standard construction risks such as falls, vehicle movement, and lifting hazards. Workers must follow OSHA regulations, including wearing hard hats, steel-toed boots, high-visibility vests, and gloves at all times, and supervisors should ensure the work area is protected with signs, cones, and traffic control measures. A Traffic Management Plan (TMP) should be developed and approved before starting work, and first aid kits and emergency equipment must be accessible and properly identified.

- Eye safety: Never look directly into a fiber optic cable or laser source; use a power meter to detect light.
- Fiber shards: Glass fragments from cutting or trimming fibers can cause serious injury. Always dispose of fiber scraps in sealed containers and wear safety glasses with side shields
