Switches in multi-ring networks use specialized protocols like ERPS, RSTP, or DLR to ensure redundancy, loop prevention, and rapid fault recovery across interconnected ring topologies.

Overview of Multi-Ring Networks

A multi-ring network consists of a major ring and one or more sub-rings, where switches are connected to form closed loops for redundancy . Each switch in the ring typically has at least two ring ports connecting to adjacent switches, while interconnection nodes may connect to sub-rings through additional ports . This topology enhances network reliability, allowing traffic to reroute in case of link or node failures.

Key Protocols for Switches in Ring Networks

- Ethernet Ring Protection Switching (ERPS/ERPS v2): Provides fast sub-50ms protection switching, loop-free operation, and supports both single- and multi-ring topologies. Switches exchange R-APS PDUs to communicate ring status and coordinate protection switching . The Ring Protection Link (RPL) is blocked under normal conditions to prevent loops, and unblocked automatically during failures to maintain connectivity .
- Rapid Spanning Tree Protocol (RSTP): An evolution of STP, RSTP detects loops and blocks redundant paths, automatically activating backup links if the primary link fail...
