Immediate Steps to Diagnose the Problem

- Check Power and Equipment Ensure that the Optical Network Terminal (ONT), switches, and routers are powered on. Restarting these devices can resolve temporary glitches or firmware issues .
- Inspect Fiber Cables and Connectors Look for visible damage such as bends, kinks, cuts, or crushed sections along the cable route. Check connectors for dirt, dust, or scratches using a fiber inspection microscope or cleaning kit . Dirty or damaged connectors are a common cause of sudden outages .
- Test Signal Strength Use an optical power meter or an Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) to measure signal loss. Values outside the normal range (typically -15 dBm to -30 dBm) indicate attenuation or a break in the fiber .
- Check Equipment Compatibility Verify that transceivers, switches, and routers are compatible and configured correctly. Mismatched wavelengths or incompatible devices can prevent the network from functioning .
