Purpose and Function

The repeated grounding electrode, also known as repeated grounding, is a connection from the neutral conductor or equipment grounding system to an additional grounding electrode at the distribution box. Its main functions are:

1. **Safety for Personnel and Equipment** Repeated grounding reduces the voltage on exposed metal parts of electrical equipment during insulation faults. 2. **Stabilization of System Voltage** By connecting the neutral or grounded conductor to multiple earth points, repeated grounding helps maintain a stable voltage relative to the earth. This prevents dangerous overvoltages during normal operation or single-phase ground faults, ensuring the distribution network operates safely and reliably .
3. **Facilitation of Fault Detection** A low-resistance path to earth allows sufficient fault current to flow during a ground fault, which quickly triggers protective devices such as circuit breakers or fuses. This rapid disconnection prevents prolonged exposure to hazardous voltages and limits potential equipment damage .
4. **Reduction of Earth Potential Rise (EPR)** In low-voltage networks, repeated grounding lowers the impedance between the system and the general mass of the earth. This reduces th...
