

The wireless router does not have an optical fiber cable

You can use a wireless router without a fiber port by connecting it to an ISP-provided Optical Network Terminal (ONT) via Ethernet.

How It Works

Fiber internet delivers data through light signals in fiber-optic cables, which cannot connect directly to most consumer routers. To bridge this gap, your Internet Service Provider (ISP) typically installs an Optical Network Terminal (ONT). The ONT converts the fiber signal into a standard Ethernet connection that your router can use .

Steps to Connect Your Router

- **Confirm ONT Installation:** Ensure your ISP has installed and activated the ONT at your home .
- **Connect the ONT to Your Router:** Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to your router's WAN port .
- **Power On Devices:** Turn on both the ONT and your router, and wait for the indicator lights to stabilize .
- **Configure Router Settings:** Access your router's admin panel to set up Wi-Fi SSID, password, and any required VLAN, DHCP, or PPPoE settings as specified by your ISP .
- **Connect Devices Wirelessly:** Once configured, your devices can connect to the router via Wi-Fi .
