Overview

They operate at the physical layer of the OSI model, performing photoelectric conversion to transmit and receive data efficiently over long distances . These modules are increasingly critical in high-bandwidth applications, including 5G networks, telecom infrastructure, and AI-driven data centers .

Structure and Components

A typical optical module consists of:

- Optical Transmitter (TOSA): Contains a laser diode (LD) or LED that converts electrical signals into modulated optical signals.
- Optical Receiver (ROSA): Includes a photodetector that converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals.
- Driver and Amplifier Circuits: Process electrical signals before transmission and amplify received signals for accurate output.
- Optical and Electrical Interfaces: Connect the module to fiber cables and networking equipment
