

Troubleshooting Access Layer Switches



Article Overview

Effective troubleshooting of access layer switches involves systematically checking physical connections, power, port status, VLAN configurations, and switch software to quickly identify and resolve network issues.

Step 1: Verify Physical Layer

Start with the physical connections, as over half of network problems originate here. Check the following:

- **Power Supply:** Ensure the switch is powered on. Verify the power cable, adapter, and outlet. For PoE switches, confirm the PoE injector or power budget is sufficient .
- **Port and Cable Integrity:** Inspect Ethernet cables for damage and test by swapping with a known working cable. Check for bent pins or debris in ports and clean if necessary .
- **Indicator Lights:** Use the switch LEDs to assess status:
 - **PWR/SYS:** Steady light indicates normal power.
 - **Link/Act:** Blinking indicates active data transmission; off indicates no link.
 - **Speed:** Color codes indicate port speed (e.g., green = 1 Gbps, yellow = 100 Mbps), .

Step 2: Check Port and Device Connectivity

- Test different ports to isolate faulty ones.
- Verify that connected devices have functioning NICs and correct cabling.
- Look for link lights and error counters to detect intermittent connectivity issues
