IEC 60228 Conductor Classes

IEC 60228 is the international standard for low-voltage electrical conductors, specifying technical requirements, nominal cross-sectional areas, and conductor construction for wires ranging from 0.5 mm² to 2,500 mm². The standard classifies conductors into four main classes based on construction and flexibility:

- Class 1 – Solid Conductor: Single rigid wire, used for fixed installations where high rigidity is required. Offers the lowest resistance and is suitable for permanent wiring in distribution boxes.
- Class 2 – Stranded Conductor: Multiple strands twisted together, providing moderate flexibility. Commonly used in fixed wiring where some bending is needed.
- Class 5 – Flexible Conductor: Fine strands for applications requiring frequent bending or movement, such as connections to devices or machinery.
- Class 6 – Extra-Flexible Conductor: Very fine strands for highly flexible applications, often used in control panels or portable equipment. Understanding these classes helps select the appropriate wire for safety, durability, and compliance with installation requirements....
