4. **Dome-Shaped Boxes** These boxes can be installed aerially or underground, providing protection against environmental factors. Their shape allows flexible deployment in diverse network scenarios .
5. **Splitter Distribution Boxes** These boxes integrate fiber termination, splicing, and PLC optical splitters. They distribute optical signals from feeder cables to multiple drop cables, typically located at distribution points in FTTH networks, such as corridors, small community telecom rooms, or wall-mounted outdoor locations .
