Eye and Laser Safety

Never look directly into a fiber optic cable, as the light may be invisible and can cause eye damage. Always ensure the fiber is dark before inspection, using a fiber optic power meter to confirm no signal is present. When using microscopes, prefer electronic displays or infrared filters to avoid focusing laser light into your eyes. Even low-power LEDs can pose risks if concentrated through optical instruments, so always wear safety glasses during splicing and termination tasks .

Handling Fiber Scraps

Fiber scraps are extremely sharp and can penetrate skin or eyes. Use tweezers to pick up cleaved fiber pieces and place them in a dedicated, sealed container for disposal. Avoid dropping scraps on the floor or leaving them on work surfaces, as they can stick to clothing or shoes and cause injury later. Maintain good housekeeping by cleaning the work area thoroughly after splicing .
