

What does single-mode 4-core fiber optic cable mean

A single-mode four-core fiber optic cable is a fiber cable containing four individual single-mode fibers, each capable of transmitting a single light mode over long distances with minimal signal loss.

What Single-Mode Means

Single-mode fiber has a very small core diameter, typically around 8–10 microns, which allows only one mode of light to propagate through the fiber. This design minimizes modal dispersion, enabling high-bandwidth transmission over long distances, often several kilometers to tens of kilometers, without the need for signal repeaters. Single-mode fibers are commonly used in telecommunications, long-haul networks, and backbone connections where signal integrity and distance are critical .

What Four-Core Means

A four-core fiber optic cable contains four separate single-mode fibers bundled within a single cable sheath. Each core functions independently, allowing four separate optical signals to be transmitted simultaneously. This configuration is often used in FTTH (Fiber to the Home), GPON (Gigabit Passive Optical Networks), and other multi-user or multi-channel applications, providing redundancy or multiple communication channels in a single cable .
