In computer networking, Gigabit Ethernet (GbE or 1 GigE) is the transmission of Ethernet frames at a rate of a gigabit per second. The most popular variant, 1000BASE-T, is defined by the IEEE 802. Cisco introduces GPON with the Catalyst GPON platform. A Gigabit switch (also called a Gigabit network switch) is a hardware device that connects multiple computers, servers, or IoT devices in a Local Area Network (LAN) and allows data transfer at 1 Gbps (1,000 Mbps) per port. It operates at a 1310nm wavelength and is widely used in enterprise, campus, and access networks where copper cabling or short-reach multimode optics are no. SFP ports are commonly found in switches, routers, network interface cards (NICs), and other networking equipment. They come in various form factors such as SFP, SFP+, QSFP+, and XFP.
