

What is a fiber optic second-stage splitter

A fiber optic second-stage splitter is a cascaded optical splitter in a two-stage FTTH network that further divides signals closer to end-users, optimizing fiber usage and network reach.

Overview

A second-stage splitter is part of a two-stage or cascaded splitting architecture in FTTH networks. Unlike a first-stage splitter, which divides the optical signal from the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) into multiple outputs at a central location, the second-stage splitter is installed closer to the end-users, such as in a local residence, community, or distribution box. Its main purpose is to further split the signal from the first-stage splitter to serve individual Optical Network Terminals (ONTs).

How It Works

In a typical two-stage splitting setup:

- First-stage splitter: Located in an optical distribution box or central office, with a split ratio like 1:4 or 1:8.
- Second-stage splitter: Located closer to the user, with a split ratio like 1:8 or 1:16.
- Signal path: OLT → First-stage splitter → Second-stage splitter → ONU/ONT. This cascaded approach allows a single OLT port to serve a larger number of users efficiently while reducing the total fiber length and infrastructure costs....
