- **Coating and Buffering:** After drawing, fibers are coated with protective layers to enhance flexibility, durability, and resistance to environmental factors. Secondary coatings may be applied via extrusion lines to further protect the fiber .
- **Stranding and Cabling:** Multiple fibers are bundled together using stranding machines, such as SZ stranding lines, to form the cable core. Cabling machines align, twist, and insulate fibers to create a stable and organized cable structure .
- **Jacketing and Sheathing:** The final protective layer is applied using jacketing lines, which shield the fibers from mechanical stress, moisture, and other environmental hazards .
