

What is the highest possible height for fiber optic cable poles

Fiber optic cable poles typically range from 10 to 15 meters in height, depending on the environment and pole type.

Standard Heights by Environment

- Urban Areas: Poles are generally 10-12 meters high, often made of concrete, to accommodate traffic, buildings, and other infrastructure while maintaining safe clearances for pedestrians and vehicles .
- Suburban/Rural Areas: Wooden poles are commonly used with heights of 12-15 meters, providing sufficient clearance over roads, vegetation, and property boundaries .
- Extreme or Special Environments: Reinforced steel lattice structures may be used with heights up to 20 meters or more, especially for long spans, high wind areas, or crossings over rivers and highways .

Key Considerations

- Pole Spacing: Urban poles are typically spaced 25-40 meters apart, while suburban and rural poles can be spaced 40-50 meters, with extreme environments allowing up to 67 meters between poles .
- Sag and Tension: Maintain cable sag at 1-2% of the span length to prevent excessive tension, which could damage the fiber .
- Environmental Loads: Poles must withstand wind, ice, and temperature fluctuatio...
