It is non-conductive and highly flame-retardant, suitable for installations in ceilings, ducts, or other plenum areas where fire codes require plenum-rated cabling .

Selection Considerations

- **Environmental Conditions:** PVC is suitable for standard indoor use, LSZH for low-smoke and halogen-free requirements, and OFNP for plenum spaces.
- **Fire Safety Compliance:** LSZH and OFNP are preferred in areas with strict fire codes.
- **Mechanical Protection:** All materials provide a protective layer for the tight-buffer...
