

What is the red wire on the outdoor optical cable

The red wire in an outdoor optical cable is typically a color-coded fiber used to identify a specific core or strand within the cable for installation, splicing, or maintenance purposes.

Purpose of the Red Wire

In outdoor fiber optic cables, each individual fiber is often coated with a colored jacket to distinguish it from other fibers. The red color is part of the standardized fiber color code defined by EIA/TIA-598, which helps technicians quickly identify and manage fibers during installation or repair. This is especially important in multi-fiber cables where multiple strands are bundled together, as it prevents confusion and ensures correct splicing or connection.

Color Coding in Outdoor Cables

Outdoor optical cables, such as loose tube (GYXTW) or layer-stranded cables (GYTS, GYTA), often contain multiple fibers inside protective tubes or bundles. Each fiber is dyed with a distinct color, including red, blue, green, yellow, and others, to simplify identification during network deployment. The red fiber does not carry a special signal by itself; its significance is purely for visual identification within the cable structure.
