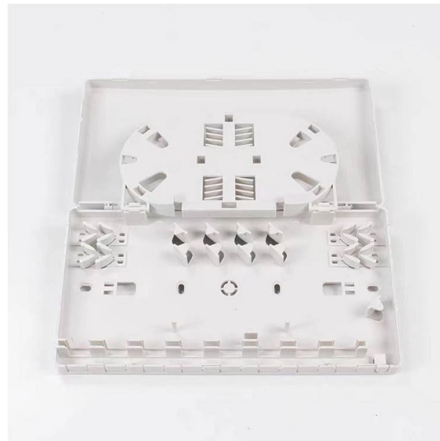


What is the safe distance between power communication fiber optic cables and 35kV cables



Article Overview

For 35kV power lines, a minimum separation of approximately 36 inches (914 mm) is recommended for parallel runs with fiber optic cables, with perpendicular crossings allowed at minimal separation.

Parallel Installation

When fiber optic cables run parallel to 35kV power cables, electromagnetic interference (EMI) and safety concerns require maintaining a safe distance. According to OSHA and NESC guidelines, the minimum approach distance for power lines between 15kV and 37kV is 36 inches (914 mm) . This distance helps prevent induced voltages and ensures personnel safety during maintenance. Best engineering practices often recommend increasing separation beyond the minimum, especially for long parallel runs, to further reduce EMI and maintain signal integrity .

Perpendicular Crossings

If the fiber optic cable crosses the 35kV power cable, the separation requirement can be significantly reduced. The NEC and TIA standards recommend that cables cross at a 90-degree angle, minimizing the length of parallel exposure and reducing inductive coupling . In this configuration, the two-inch (50 mm) minimum separation is generally sufficient for safety and signal integrity....
