

What is the standard cost for laying high-altitude optical cables

High-altitude (aerial) fiber optic cable installation typically costs between \$3 and \$7 per linear foot, with additional expenses for labor, permits, and specialized equipment.

Cost Breakdown

Cable Materials: Standard outdoor fiber optic cables for aerial deployment cost approximately \$1 to \$6 per foot, depending on fiber type, strand count, and whether the cable is armored or self-supporting . ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) cables, which do not require a messenger wire, are commonly used for high-altitude installations and may be at the higher end of this range . **Labor and Installation:** Certified aerial technicians are required for high-altitude work, and labor costs vary by region and project complexity. Typical installation labor for aerial fiber ranges from \$3 to \$7 per foot, including pole attachment, tensioning, and splicing . Bucket truck rentals for elevated work can cost \$300-\$600 per day, and safety equipment and fall protection add overhead . **Permits and Coordination:** Pole attachment permits, utility coordination, and right-of-way approvals can add \$50-\$150 per span or more, depending on local regulations and urban density . Complex urban or high-altitude routes may require additional planning and safety measures, increasing costs. **Splicing and Hardware:** Splice enclosures, termination boxes, and weather-resistant hardware typically cost \$100-\$300 per location, and pre-terminated assemblies can reduce field labor but increase material costs
