

What is the total length of the cable tray support



Overview

The NEC requires that cable trays must be supported by members at an interval specified by the cable tray manufacturer, but not more than 5 feet for horizontal runs to support the weight of the cables and other loads. The NEC has a requirement for ladder-type cable trays. Cable tray support quantity can be calculated using a simple formula: $\text{Support Quantity} = \text{Total Length} \div \text{Support Spacing} + 1$ $20 \div 2 + 1 = 11$ supports. In a typical project, a 20-meter cable tray with 2-meter spacing requires 11 supports. The rungs cannot be more. In practice, cable tray dimensions are a system of interrelated measurements —width, depth, length, and material thickness—that directly affect cable fill compliance, heat dissipation, structural loading, and long-term expandability. A tray that is too small will overheat and physically damage, and too large tray will drain the project budget. It is grounded on 40 years of experience in the manufacturing.
