The most common voltage levels used in distribution networks are 33kV, 22kV, and 11kV for primary distribution and 415V and 230V for secondary distribution. These levels are chosen to ensure efficient power delivery, minimize losses, and provide safe electricity for all types of. Distribution substations connect to the transmission system and lower the transmission voltage to medium voltage ranging between 2 kV and 33 kV with the use of transformers. Primary distribution lines carry this medium voltage power to distribution transformers located near the customer's. Secondary distribution voltage represents the final stage of electricity delivery, marking the point where high-voltage power is converted into a form safe and usable for homes and businesses. The secondary distribution network carries low-voltage electricity (typically 230 V to 415 V) from these transformers to homes, shops, and. Nearly all spot networks in North America function at a 480Y/277-V secondary voltage.
