Overview

At least one socket-outlets circuit rated 16 A (rating according to National socket-outlet system), each circuit supplying a reasonable number of socket-outlets in series, taking into account the wiring cross-section area used (1.5 mm²), the wiring. A distribution board or distribution box is where the main power supply is distributed to multiple loads. And all the switching and protective devices are installed in the distribution box. The proper separation of circuits provides service continuity and eases rapid location of fault. National standards commonly recommend the subdivision of circuits according to the number of utilization categories in the installation concerned (see Figure Q10): At least one socket-outlets circuit. 1 RCBO boards provide individual RCD and overcurrent protection per circuit, eliminating the nuisance tripping and loss-of-supply issues that affect split-load and dual-RCD configurations. 2 All consumer units in domestic premises must be constructed from non-combustible material (typically metal). Socket Rings: Three separate ring circuits are often used for sockets around the home, one upstairs, one downstairs and one for the kitchen. Each separate ring is fed from the consumer unit via an individual 32A type B circuit breaker and a separate 30mA RCCB via a split load board or a combined. A ring circuit is one of the most common wiring configurations used in UK homes, particularly for socket outlets.
