Natural Disasters: Severe weather events such as floods, hurricanes, ice storms, landslides, and earthquakes can physically damage fiber optic lines. Aerial cables are particularly vulnerable to strong winds or falling trees, while buried cables can be stressed or broken by shifting soil .

Animal Activity: Rodents and other wildlife, including squirrels, gophers, and even stray dogs, can chew through the protective sheathing of fiber cables. This is especially common in rural or forested areas, where underground cables are accessible to animals .

Vandalism and Intentional Damage: In some cases, fiber optic cables are deliberately cut for malicious purposes, theft, or sabotage. While less common than accidental damage, intentional cuts can have significant impacts on connectivity .

Equipment or Infrastructure Failures: Rarely, defects in the cable itself, faulty connectors, or errors during splicing and maintenance can lead to fiber cuts, interrupting service .
