Faulty or Improper Wiring: During construction, electrical systems are often temporary and incomplete. Damaged insulation, exposed wires, or improperly installed connections can lead to short circuits and overheating, which are frequent precursors to fires . **Overloaded Circuits:** Construction sites use high-power tools and machinery, which can exceed the capacity of circuits. Overloading causes wires to heat up, potentially igniting nearby combustible materials . **Short Circuits and Leakage:** A short circuit occurs when a live wire contacts another conductor or the ground, causing a sudden surge of current and intense heat. Leakage currents from damaged insulation or environmental factors like moisture can also generate localized high temperatures, sparking fires . **Environmental and Physical Damage:** Exposure to wind, rain, humidity, high temperatures, or physical impacts can degrade insulation and brackets, increasing the risk of electrical faults . **Equipment Malfunction:** Tools or machinery with damaged cords or internal faults can produce sparks or arcs that ignite fires, particularly in areas with flammable construction materials .
