

Wire-binding optical cable



Article Overview

Optical cables are typically bound using specialized binder yarns, aramid fibers, or thin galvanized tie wires to secure and protect the fibers during installation.

Binder Yarns and Strength Members

Fiber-optic cables often include binder yarns or strength members to hold the fibers in place and prevent damage from tension or bending. Aramid fibers, commonly known by the trade name Kevlar, are widely used because they are extremely strong, do not stretch under tension, and provide cushioning for the delicate optical fibers inside the cable. These fibers are essential for both indoor and outdoor cables, ensuring that pulling or handling does not damage the optical cores (The FOA Reference for Fiber Optics) .

Tie Wires

For certain applications, especially in overhead or lashed cable installations, thin galvanized iron or PVC-coated tie wires are used to bind the optical cable to a host conductor or support structure. These wires are typically around 0.75 mm in diameter and come in rolls for easy handling. Care must be taken during winding to avoid breaking or scratching the wire, which could compromise the cable's integrity (0.75mm 50m Tie Wire Roll Galvanized Iron PVC Coated Wire for Binding) .
