Wires

A wire is a single conductor, usually made of copper or aluminum, used to carry electrical current or signals. Wires can be bare (without insulation) or insulated with materials like plastic or cloth. They are classified by cross-sectional area: small wires ($\leq 6 \text{ mm}^2$) and large wires ($> 6 \text{ mm}^2$). Wires are typically used for short-distance connections or simple electrical circuits, and their performance depends on diameter, material, and insulation type .

Cables

A cable is an assembly of two or more wires twisted or bundled together, often with insulation and an outer protective sheath. Cables are designed for transmitting electrical signals over longer distances and can carry multiple signals simultaneously. Common types include:

- Twisted pair cables: Pairs of insulated copper wires twisted together to reduce electromagnetic interference. Variants include Unshielded Twisted Pair (UTP) and Shielded Twisted Pair (STP) .
